## The Alpine Convention and the Mountain at EXPO 2015: “Mountain week”, 4<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> June 2015

### 1. Introduction

Following the interest expressed within the Alpine Convention and on the basis of the programme of the Italian Presidency, the Italian Ministry of the Environment Land and Sea promotes the organization of the **“Mountain Week” (4<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> June 2015)** that will take place inside and outside EXPO Milan 2015. The organization of the event will have the active collaboration of the governments of the Alpine States, the Permanent Secretariat and the Observers of the Alpine Convention as well as other stakeholders at different administrative levels, the private sector and the civil society.

The “Mountain Week”<sup>1</sup>, coordinated by the Italian Ministry of the Environment, will include events organized by different actors and located in several Pavilions, in other places of the city of Milan or in the alpine territories; it will spread over several months (end of 2014 –closing of EXPO) through:

- a **unitary agenda** promoted as an integrated activity;
- a **logo and a unitary "corporate identity"**;
- **joint promotion and communication activities through a recognizable format**;
- **the use of a strategy and an *ad hoc* mix of media (especially the “new media”)**;
- **the development of a web site/blog and a smartphone application (“Mountain WApp”) that guides the visitors along a mountain path through the Pavilions** and provides information about the products, area of origin and mountain territories;
- **thematic and identity connection through the initiatives** of the “Mountain Week” based on the scientific research.

**The Alpine Convention asks the Alpine national governments, the Regions, the local authorities<sup>2</sup> and all the public and private entities that may be interested to provide information about the concept of possible initiatives to be included in the “Mountain Week” programme during EXPO Milan 2015.** These initiatives shall be organized independently by the promoters, although they may see a participation of the Presidency of the Alpine Convention or other expert authorities. Upon request from other local partners, whether public or private, joint initiatives could be developed.

Furthermore, negotiations with several Alpine and Carpathian national Pavilions, present at EXPO Milan 2015, are in process, also with the support of the *ad interim* Secretariat of the Carpathian Convention –UNEP.

In order to be included in the programme of the “Mountain Week” the activities should:

- be **thematically coherent with the theme of EXPO Milan 2015 “Feeding the Planet, Energy for Life”**;

- have a clear **reference to the typical territories, products, cultural-social –economical and identity aspects of mountain areas;**
- be thematically coherent with the concept of sustainable development of mountain areas;
- **take place preferably from 4<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> June 2015**, or during the semester of EXPO Milan 2015, or at least during 2015;
- **take place preferably inside the exhibition site of EXPO Milan 2015, or in the metropolitan area of Milan**, or in the neighboring areas or in the mountain areas.

The initiatives submitted to the Alpine Convention will be inserted in the programme on the basis of a theme and content evaluation. The selected ones will be able to use the “Mountain Week” logo and will be included into the promotional campaigns of the Presidency.

The proposals received are inscribed into the **summary table below**, that presents the initiatives promoted in the framework of EXPO Milan 2015, in national pavilions and in other sites inside or outside the exhibition area, are presented.

## ***2. The project of the Italian Presidency of the Alpine Convention for EXPO Milan 2015***

In order to provide a good visibility and an institutional scope to the “Mountain Week”, the Italian Ministry of the Environment will organize **two main events, an opening (on 4<sup>th</sup> June) and a closing one (on 11<sup>th</sup> June)**. They'll be both dedicated to global and mountain issues and will draw from the international mountain cooperation experience developed over the years with the Carpathian Convention and other mountain territories, as well as the work of international working groups dedicated to mountain farming and to the “labeling” of quality products.

**The opening and closing events will take place in the exhibition site of EXPO Milan 2015 or in the city of Milan**, and will include cases and institutions of excellence in the Alpine and international framework, with particular reference to cross-border cooperation between territories with food excellence, sustainable agriculture production and “green economy”. The two events are proposed and organized by the Italian Ministry Environment in collaboration with other entities and stakeholders described below<sup>3</sup>
