3. Activities carried out

Report on activities carried out (including meetings, conferences)

- Report on the state of the Alps was prepared in English language including good practice examples from all member states; finalised report in all Alpine languages is available for approval of the ministers at the XV Alpine Conference.
- Knowledge transfer and exchange of good natural disaster risk reduction practices as well as current natural hazard events was carried out at all meetings of PLANALP - respective documentation is available in the minutes of the meetings (point 2); further PLANALP exchanged good practice examples in course of the preparation of RSA 7.

- The Conference on the Role of women in mountain regions, held on 18-19 April 2017 in Alpbach, was organized by the Austrian presidency and allowed women from all over the world discussion on the involvement of women in different sectors. At this conference PLANALP presented the videos about women involved in the field of natural hazards which were produced for the exhibition in Hittisau (women´s museum).
- PLANALP contributed to the We are Alps tour 2017 on the topic of “Water in the Alps”. Journalists visited Schladming (AT), where participants received information about natural hazards protection in alpine regions and on the activities of PLANALP.
