

MANDATE OF THE AD HOC WORKING GROUP on *Multi-Annual Work Programme 2023-2030* for the period 2021-2022 until the XVII Alpine Conference

1. Introductory remarks

Through the Alpine Conference's Multi-Annual Work Programme (MAP), the Contracting Parties, together with the Observers, express their conviction that the challenges the Alpine region is facing – inter alia climatic, cultural and demographic changes – require a cooperative approach that transgresses national borders.

The aim of the MAP is to define the context for cooperation on common measures over an extended period. These ambitions are reflected in the choice of areas of emphasis as selected and defined within a long-term timeframe.

The adopted MAP 2023-2030 will be communicated on the online channels of the Alpine Convention. Further communication and networking activities are carried out as required.
