

ACTIVITY REPORT OF THE Ad hoc Working Group for the Preparation of the Multi-Annual Work Programme (MAP) 2023-2030 FOR THE PERIOD **2021-2022** (BETWEEN THE XVI AND XVII MEETINGS OF THE ALPINE CONFERENCE)

1. Overview of the mandate given by the XVI Alpine Conference

2. Meetings

Summary of the meetings held (date, place, main topics and milestones)

The ad hoc WG MAP met three times in official meetings. Additionally, there were two online workshops in May and June 2021 with participation of the WG MAP and further stakeholders. The roadMAP tour in September 2021 is listed in chapter 3.

- 29 April 2021 (online): First meeting of the WG MAP. Discussions on general expectations, vision for the Alpine region by 2030, main architecture of the MAP and the most pressing challenges in the Alpine region until 2030. Based on these challenges, the group decided on three workshop topics "climate change", "biodiversity and ecosystems" and "quality of life" to be held before summer.
- 27 May 2021 (online): Workshop on "quality of life" and "climate change"
- 30 June 2021 (online): Workshop on "biodiversity and ecosystems" and discussion on the draft structure
- 25 January 2022 (online): Second meeting of the WG MAP. Discussion of the first draft and the roadmap.
- 24 May 2022 (online): Third meeting of the WG MAP. Discussion of the final draft and handover to the Permanent Committee for its 75th meeting.

3. Activities carried out

Synthetic description of further activities carried out (including outreach and communication activities)

Within the "roadMAP" tour in September 2021 six national workshops were organised over the span of two weeks. In total approximately 90 persons participated, representing very diverse institutions, some also from beyond the Alpine Convention circle. The series of workshops was organised to gain input from a broader stakeholder basis on the three structuring topics (climate change, biodiversity & ecosystems and quality of life) and the implementation, communication and monitoring of the MAP. The stops of the roadMAP tour were the following:

- o 6 September 2021: Bolzano/Bozen, Italy
- o 7 September 2021: Bohinj, Slovenia
- o 8 September 2021: Vienna, Austria
- o 9 September 2021: Munich, Germany
- o 13 September 2021: Berne, Switzerland
- o 14 September 2021: Chambéry, France

4. Outputs and results

Description of the main outputs and results achieved

• The final draft of the Multi-Annual Work Programme 2023-2030 will be handed over to the XVII Alpine Conference for adoption.

5. Cooperation

- Members from all (non-ad hoc) Thematic Working Bodies participated as members in the WG MAP and contributed to the development of the MAP 2023-2030. These members also shared the MAP development process and progress therein in their respective TWB meetings.
- The tentative contents of the MAP were presented to all TWBs in the TWB Workshop on 25 January 2022.
